Hunter, Jumper, Equitation & Combined Divisions

Division with less than 3 classes, a Division Champion will not be awarded.
Divisions or under saddles with less than 3 in a class, a Division Champion will not be awarded.

Equitation Champion

In case of a tie score the Championship and/or Reserve is awarded to the rider that accumulated the most points over fences.

Jumper Champion

Points are based on - First Place...10 points, Second Place...6 points, Third Place...4 points, Fourth Place...2 points, Fifth Place...1 point, Sixth Place...1/2 point.

In case of a tie the last class points will be based on Bonus Points - First Place...15 points, Second Place...9 points, Third Place...6 points, Fourth Place...3 points, Fifth Place...2 points, Sixth Place...1 point. In the event there is still a tie the one with the most points in the first class breaks the tie.

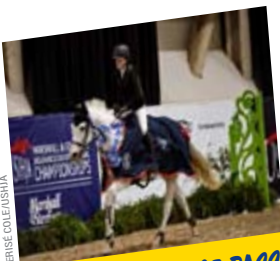

USHJA Outreach Competitions and Classes provide opportunity to earn national recognition in classes from walk/trot to 3'0" in hunter, equitation, and .60m-1.20m in jumper sections at rated and unrated local shows.

Rewards

Riders and owners of USHJA Outreach registered horses can earn level status and points to redeem at the end of the year for items such as USHJA logo wear, Outreach ribbons or Outreach medallions.

Bronze Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 50-74 points during the competition year

Silver Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 75-99 points during the competition year

Gold Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 100 points during the competition year

Awards

New! Exciting year-end awards will be given to trainers, riders and horses.

Trainers—Earn the USHJA Outreach High Point Trainer Award by being the leading trainer in your zone whose riders have earned 100 or more points cumulatively in USHJA Outreach Classes.

Riders— In addition to awards and rewards, one high point rider from each Zone will earn a Golden Backstage Pass to participate in the USHJA National Championship Affiliate sections and get exclusive access to free educational sessions and National Championship Grand Prix and Hunter Derby course walks!

Horses—While horse recording and microchipping is not required to participate in Outreach classes, owners wishing for their horses to earn points must have them recorded with USHJA (\$20/annual or \$75/lifetime). Horses will have their Outreach points tracked and ranked within their USHJA Zone and displayed on ushja.org.

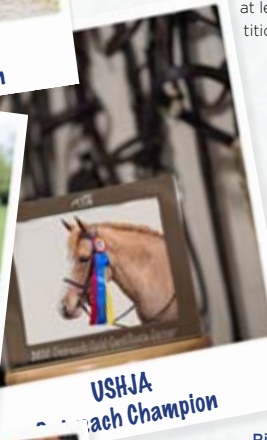

OUTREACH COMPETITION

Do you have to be a USHJA Member to participate in Outreach Competitions? Riders and trainers competing in Outreach classes do not have to be USHJA members. To be eligible for USHJA Outreach points and year-end awards, riders must be a USHJA (Outreach level or higher).

Do horses have to be USHJA registered or microchipped to participate in Outreach Competitions?

Horses are not required to be registered with USHJA or microchipped to compete in Outreach classes. However, horses wishing to accrue points toward year-end Outreach awards must be registered with USHJA and microchipped. USHJA Horse registrations are available for \$20/annual or \$75/lifetime.

Why should I compete in an Outreach competition?

Outreach offers many benefits for competitors. First, USHJA Outreach membership is FREE. Riders, trainers and USHJA registered horses are able to earn points by competing in designated classes. There are awards and rewards available in each section in each Zone. Ribbons, swag, apparel and competition opportunities at USHJA National Championship are available.

Outreach memberships also allow individuals access to USHJA's wide variety of programs and educational opportunities, many of which do not require horse ownership. Members can also apply for scholarships and grants to further their equine and academic goals.

How are points determined?

Riders: Riders must be an Outreach member (or higher) on or before the first day of competition to accrue rider points. Outreach membership is free.

Horses: Horses must be registered with USHJA for points to be tracked.

Trainers: Trainers of riders participating in the USHJA Outreach Program wishing to be recognized for year-end awards and recognition must be a USHJA Outreach member or higher on or before the first day of competition.

At least three entries must complete the class for points to count.

Points are awarded on a flat scale as follows:

1st place – 10 points	2nd place – 6 points
3rd place – 4 points	4th place – 2 points
5th place – 1 point	6th place – ½ point

How are year-end awards determined?

Rewards and awards are based on rider or horse participation across any USHJA Outreach classes. A rider or a horse may accumulate points throughout any or all of the classes, allowing for participation across the many facets of the Hunter, Jumper and Equitation competitions.

What Awards and Rewards are available?

Rewards will be given by USHJA Zone in each Outreach Hunter, Jumper or Equitation section. Rewards for competing in any USHJA Outreach Class (Hunter, Equitation, Jumper) will be based on total points earned as follows:

Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. 3. **FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulting or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Northern Winter Classic I, II, III, IV (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State.
The competition and its management agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the PCHA, its directors, officer, committee members, agents and employees from and against all loss or damage including any and all claims arising out of the competition, including claims as to personal injury or property loss or damage suffered during or in conjunction with the competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from negligent acts or omissions of said directors, officers, committee members, agents or employees.
4. **MANAGEMENT:** The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regards to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.
5. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any Riders or Competitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to Competitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in Jumper classes as competition warrants and in compliance with all Federation rules.
6. **CONDITION OF ENTRY:** Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each Competitor shall hold the individual horse shows and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities, Federation, the Competition, FoxFarms Inc, Murieta Equestrian Center and Cosumnes Corp., and its employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of each horse show and the facilities at which each horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. All owners and Competitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.
7. **STALLS:** Stall may be split between two horses for an additional \$175 fee (unable to split discounted Outreach Stalls). **Trainers will be responsible for payment of all horse & tack stalls requested after entries due date has passed. See Rule 11 for substituting a horse.** An open check or credit card authorization form is required to hold stalls. The Show Office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Request for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given. NO STRAW ALLOWED. Wood or Canvas construction: Top & bottom doors size stalls are 10 x 10, 10 X 12, 12 X 12 most with rubber mats. Anyone dismantling stalls or causing damage to a stall(s) will be charged a \$100 fee per panel, with a maximum fine of \$400 per stall.
8. **ENTRY PROCEDURES:** Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, COVID-19 and EHV materials, signatures and organizational membership numbers. Entry blanks must be postmarked on or before **Tuesday, September 1, 2026 to receive Early Entry Bundle; Tuesday, September 15 to receive Discounted Stall Price.** After Tuesday, September 22, 2026 Post Entries are accepted. For each horse entered, a check or credit card for a deposit of \$375 must be included. All horses on the grounds must have a number, even non-showing horses. Numbers will not be issued without a check or credit card covering the balance of the entries.
 - Credit cards (Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express): Card holder will be charged an additional 4% over the published rates as the rates shown in the Prize List are discounted for paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by credit card, upon receipt of the entry blank, and/or credit card authorization form, Horse Show Management will charge the credit card for the Competition registration fees. Credit cards shall be presented to Horse Show Management in the office before or at the time of close out. If such card is not presented or an alternative method of payment is not made, Rider/Trainer/Owner agrees that Horse Show Management is authorized to charge the credit card pursuant to the information contained in the entry blank at the conclusion of the Competition.
 - Cash, Check or Money Order Payments: The rates in this Prize List reflect the 4% discount if paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by check, cash, or money order please submit the required payment, made payable to FoxFarms, Inc., with a complete entry blank for each showing or non-showing entry, on or by the published Entries Due.
9. **NOMINATION FEE & ADD/SCRATCH POLICY:** Nomination Fee allows unlimited Adds/Scratches except for Featured Classes (see Rule 38) and astrid (***) marked Hunter Divisions (see rule 13D). Same day Adds/Scratches must be done on an Add/Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the Horse Show Office. Scratches made at the "backgate" will still be charged for the class. Horses scratching the show after the entries due will pay a scratch fee of \$375. Horses scratched at the show will pay \$475 unless substituting a horse. (See Rule 11).
10. **OPEN ARENA FEE:** Allows Competitors to hack in specified arenas the day before the start of the show, and as arenas are available before each show day. Jumping will only be allowed during specified hours - see office for times. Also includes a daily lungeing area. See Rule 39 for arena lights. Jumper rings close 1 hour, and hunters 30 to 45 minutes before the start of the show.
11. **HORSE SUBSTITUTION POLICY:** After Entries Due substituting a scratched horse with another horse within the same Trainer's barn is allowed, the substituted horse will pay a substitution fee of \$45 in addition to all other fees. The scratched horse will pay a scratch fee of \$275. No substituting allowed after a horse has shown. **ALL SUBSTITUTION MUST BE DONE BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW.**
12. **ENTRY BLANKS:** Care should be taken to enter each horse in its proper division or class. Competitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents completing entry blanks. In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted.
 - A. Be properly signed, and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or guardian.
 - B. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show.
 - C. Show the correct mailing address of the Owner, Trainer and Rider. Changes made after the completion of the show will be charged a Change Fee of \$50.
 - D. Social Security number must be included on entry blank, if not prize money will not be issued.
 - E. Include USEF membership numbers for each Owner, Lessee, Agent, Trainer and Rider.
 - F. Include USHJA membership numbers or pay \$30 show pass for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer & rider.
 - G. Include all additional membership numbers and birth dates of Junior and Amateur riders.
 - H. Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters and Pony Jumpers must have a USEF measurement card.
 - I. Include Microchip number on the entry blank.
 - J. A show deposit of \$375 per horse must be included with entry.
 - K. Include signed COVID-19 and EHV Release and Protocol's by rider, parent, trainer and groom as required.
 - L. Entries received at the show a rush fee of \$35 may be applied.

13. **REFUND POLICY:** All refund requests must be submitted in writing.
- A. Before entries due, Tuesday, September 22, 2026, all paid show fees will be credited or refunded.
 - B. After entries due, the Show & RV deposit will not be refunded. Horses scratching the show after the entries due will pay a scratch fee of \$375. Horses scratched at the show will pay \$475 and stall can be used as an additional tack stall unless substituting a horse. (See Rule 11). Outreach Horses scratching after the entries due will pay \$200.
 - D. After entries due, no refunds will be given unless you meet one of the following:
 - After the show starts, if a Competitor is ill or injured and cannot compete in the balance of the classes, that Competitor will be entitled to a refund of unused class fees provided the classes are officially scratched and a doctor's certificate is provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
 - After the show starts, if a horse is ill or injured may scratch classes the same day they are scheduled without penalty with an Official Show Veterinarian Certificate provided to the Horse Show Office.
 - E. No request for refunds will be accepted after the close of the show.
14. **RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK OR MINIMUM OF \$50. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash, or cash equivalent or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
15. **CREDIT CARD CHARGEBACK:** Chargebacks for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be immediately turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action. 20% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT CARD CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED OR MINIMUM OF \$300.
16. **UNPAID CHARGES:** If the Show Management or Show Official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill a Competitor/Owner for unpaid charges, a \$50 billing fee will be added to the amount due.
- A. **Past unpaid balances** – Competitor/Owner will be notified of any previous balance at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Horse Show Management reserves the right to require a deposit paid to cover all show expenses and any portion of the deposit that is unused will be mailed to the addressee on file no later than 15 days after the close of the show.
 - B. **Unpaid Balances** – Competitor/Owner who do not come into the office to close out by 5pm at the end of each show forfeit the right to adjust any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.
17. **PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money will not be deducted from the show bill, prize money will be made payable to the Payee or Owner listed if indicated on the Entry blank and mailed within 30 days after the show.
- PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER OR PAYEE'S SOCIAL SECURITY/TAX ID NUMBER IS LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK. REQUESTS MADE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL INCUR A \$100 FEE TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY. ALL CHECK REQUESTED 60 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL RECEIVE A CREDIT FOR A FUTURE SHOW. CHECKS NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL RECEIVE A CREDIT FOR A FUTURE SHOW.
 - ANY RETURNED PRIZE MONEY CHECKS DUE TO INCORRECT ADDRESS ON ENTRY BLANK A \$125 WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY.
 - REQUESTING 1099 CHANGES AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN MAILED WILL BE CHARGED \$125 TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE.
- PRIZE MONEY WON BY FOREIGN COMPETITORS: Foreign competitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money won in the United States. Foreign competitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and will be asked to complete form W-8BEN prior to the Northern Winter Classics (FoxFarms, Inc.) issuing prize money won.
- Altering Prize Money - See Rule 52.**
18. **ADD-BACK:** In classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show.
19. **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:** Horses arriving and/or departing before and/or after these dates & times will be billed \$50 per day per horse.
- Arrive no earlier than 12pm Monday, October 12, 2026, Depart by 7pm Sunday, October 18, 2026.
20. **PARKING:** Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. There will be no autos allowed in the barn area and aisles.
21. **RVs:** Weekly rate of \$400 30amps, \$450 50amps, \$500 30amps, w/sewer, please book your RV space at www.murietaautumnclassic.com, if cancelled before the entries due date a credit will be provided for current or future show. The RV deposit of \$125 is non-refundable after entries due date. **RV'S ARRIVING WITHOUT A RESERVATION WILL PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$100 OVER THE WEEKLY RATE, AS SPACE ALLOWS. RV'S arriving and/or departing before and/or after the scheduled dates & times will be billed a minimum of \$50 per day. See Rule 19.**
22. **FEED AND BEDDING:** All orders must be made through the Horse Show Office (916) 305-8898.
23. **MEDICAL WASTE:** Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.
24. **MEASURING OF ENTRIES:** Time of measuring will be posted in the Horse Show Office. ALL HUNTER AND JUMPER PONIES AND JUNIOR HUNTERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF OR THEIR ORIGINAL MEASUREMENT CARDS PRESENTED TO ONE OF THE SHOW SECRETARIES OR BE MEASURED IF THE CARD IS NOT AVAILABLE, BEFORE THE COMPETITORS' NUMBER WILL BE RELEASED.
25. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** USEF GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
26. **NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each Horse. Horses are now required to have a back number attached to their neck or their rider when outside of their barn/portable stall (as per HJ106.2 #247-22). Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
27. **COURSES:** Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post & Rails, Banks, Ditches, Coups, Logs, Barrels & Liverpools. The horse show management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in jumper classes as competition warrants.
28. **POLING:** Not allowed in California.
29. **HARD HATS:** USEF GR801.2 It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.
30. **SAFETY:** Accidents involving Competitors. GR849. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the Competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the Competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The Competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

31. **DOGS:** USEF GR1301.6 - Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
32. **SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Please be advised that paddock stewards are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF schooling rules. They can scratch riders without going through the USEF Steward or the Horse Show Manager.
33. **TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER:** Each day by 7pm the next day's time schedule will be available on www.horseshowing.com. This time schedule and/or posted orders will be strictly adhered to. The Trainer, Competitor or other representative must tell the paddock steward of possible ring conflicts so that arrangements can be made to accommodate the rider as well as the time schedule. All management decisions will be final. Order of go will be drawn according to USEF Rule JP111.2.
34. **ARENAS:** All show and warm-up arenas consist of GGT footing.
Jumper 1 - 120' X 240' Hunter 1 - 105' X 240' Hunter 2 - 105' X 240' Hunter 3 - 105' X 240'
35. **HAUL INS:** A \$75 haul-in fee per horse per day will be allowed at each show if the entry is received or on before the "Entry Due Date" with a payment on file. After Entry Due Date only stalls will be available. Horses coming from VS Affected Counties will not be able to haul-in and will require a stall. Horses coming from an affected County will be required to meet VS Show Protocols which can be found at: www.murietaautumnclassics.com
36. **NON SHOWING POLICY:** For any horse on the grounds not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete a entry blank and write in the in the area of the Entry Blank used for classes "Non-Showing" and sign the entry blank at the Horse Show Office, pay a \$175 non showing fee, Medic Fee, Environmental Fee and a stall fee.
37. **2026 ZONE 10 SPECIFICATIONS:** Please see USEF.org & USHJA.org for current class specification with regards to; Children's Hunters, Adult Amateur Hunters, Green Hunter, Low Children's Jumpers, Low Adult Amateur Jumpers, Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers, Classics.
38. **FEATURED JUMPER, HUNTER & MEDAL CLASSES:**
- Horses entering the same day may be required to go first.
 - Featured Classes added the same day will pay an additional post entry fee of \$50.
 - Featured Classes same say scratch pays 50% of the entry fee.
39. **ARENA LIGHTS:** Lights will be on in the GGT & Stable Mix Arenas one hour (1) prior to the start of the show each day and turned off at the conclusion of the show each day.
40. **EQUINE VACCINATION RULE GR845:** At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See USEF.org for outline of documentation required.
41. **HUNTER CLASSES:** Requiring a jog will trot a circle at the end of their round on a loose rein.
42. **OPEN HUNTER CLASSIC:** This is a two round hunter classic open to Green Hunters, 3', 3'3", 3'6", 3'9", High Performance Hunters, Performance Hunters 3'3" & 3'6", and USHJA 3' Hunters. See USEF.org, Rule HU173. The last class of the division is the first round of the Open Hunter Classic.
43. **HUNTER CLASSICS:** Hunter Classics are two rounds. The last class of the division is the first round of the Hunter Classic.
44. **TRAINER SPLITS:** This service allows Trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until 5pm Friday any splits after Friday will subject to a \$5 office charge per entry. Only items billed by the horse show will be split. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected. FEED & BEDDING ORDERS AFTER 5pm FRIDAY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SPLIT AND WILL BE BILLED TO THE TRAINER.
45. **PRIZE MONEY:** Classes awarding prize money must have at least three entries to complete the course in order to receive prize money, unless otherwise specified by USEF rules.
USHJA Derbies Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-7%, 5th-5%, 6th-5%, 7th-4%, 8th-3%, 9th-3%, 10th-12th-2%.
Hunter Classes & Classics 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.
Jumper Classics & Welcome Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-16%, 4th-12%, 5th-10%, 6th-10%.
Grand Prix Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.
46. **FACILITY ENVIRONMENTAL/MANURE REMOVAL FEE:** All horses entered in the show must pay a \$50 Murieta Equestrian Center Environmental/Manure Removal Fee.
47. **COVID-19:** All Competitors, Trainers, Staff and additional personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and Sacramento County, requirements and guidelines as they relate to COVID-19 and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.northernwinterclassics.com.
48. **Equine Herpes Virus (EHV) & Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) :** All Competitors, Trainers, Owners, Staff and additional Personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and California State requirements and guidelines as they relate to EHV, VS and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.murietaautumnclassic.com. Management may impose a Biosecurity fee.

49. **SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
50. **SAFETY & WELFARE:** All horses must pay a \$75 EMT Standby Fee.

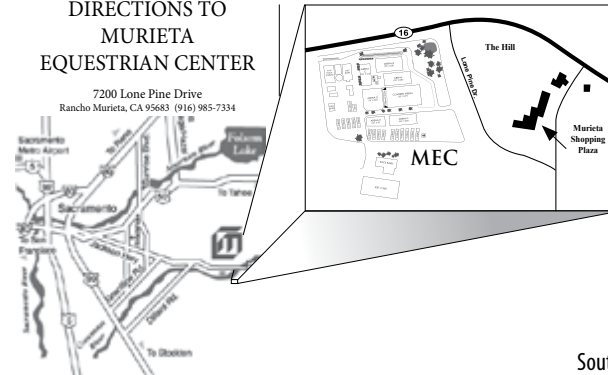
